- Travel Safely by Helicopter to an Offshore Installation.
- Live and Work Safely on an Offshore Installation.
- Respond to Offshore Installation Emergencies.

Course Objectives:

- (a) Identify the generic hazards which are specific to offshore oil and gas installations, potential risks associated with those hazards, and how controls are put in place.
- (b) Identify key offshore related safety regulations and explain the basic safety concepts
- (c) Demonstrate, in a simulated environment, that they can use the safety equipment, and follow procedures in preparing for, and during helicopter emergencies with particular focus on escaping from a helicopter following ditching
- (d) Demonstrate sea survival and first aid techniques
- (e) Demonstrate that they can effectively use basic firefighting equipment, and practise self-rescue techniques in low visibility situations, including smoke-filled areas. The aim of this course is to ensure that new entrants to the industry.

Learning outcomes:

ensure that all personnel working offshore achieve the following:

- 1) Awareness of the risks to which they are exposed and how they are managed
- 2) An understanding of the essential safety rules with which they must comply and how to act in an emergency
- 3) An increase in their personal commitment to work safely
- 4) Effective use of personal safety equipment.
