- Travel Safely by Helicopter to an Offshore Installation.
- Use of Compressed Air Emergency Breathing System (CAEBS)
- Respond to Offshore Installation Emergencies.

Course Objectives:

- (a) Demonstrate, in a simulated environment, that they can use the safety equipment and follow procedures in preparing for and during helicopter emergencies – with particular focus on escaping from a helicopter following ditching.
- (b) Demonstrate that they can use basic firefighting equipment effectively and use self-rescue techniques in low visibility and completely obscured visibility situations e.g. smoke-filled areas.
- (c) Demonstrate that they can perform basic first aid.

Learning outcomes:

- Course participants will gain a basic level of understanding and an awareness of safety & emergency procedures on offshore installations, and will be required to demonstrate their skills, knowledge & understanding in the following course module
- Safety and the Environment
 - Helicopter Safety & Escape and Use of Compressed Air Emergency Breathing System (CAEBS)
 - Fire Fighting & Self Rescue. Further Emergency First Aid
