

## 5.6.5 Childcare Facilities for Staff and Faculty

AASTMT recognises that dependable childcare is essential for its people and works to create a supportive, inclusive environment for colleagues with young children. In practice, AASTMT's Protocol & Public Relations unit maintains staff arrangements with local nurseries—published openly as part of staff discounts (e.g., ABC Nursery in Smouha and others)—to ease access and cost for childcare. (AASTMT) On the Smart Village campus, AASTMT operates within the Smart Village business park, so staff based there benefit from proximity to the park's on-site nursery service and family-oriented amenities, as described by Smart Village itself; AASTMT's own pages and news also emphasise the campus' advanced facilities that support day-to-day work and study.
