

The College of International Transport and Logistics is a professional entity specializing in teaching the multidisciplinary fields of Logistics and supply chain management.


The Departments are Logistics of International Transport, Logistics & Supply chain Management, Logistics of International Trade and Energy & Petroleum Logistics Management.
