Within the results of the Times Higher Education Impact Rankings 2025 that is considered to be one of the top ratings for the world universities that are committed to fostering the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), and working towards equality and a sustainable future. The results of the most recent ranking in 2025 indicated that the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport (AASTMT) achieved a remarkable progress at local, regional and international levels.




Alumni Engagement in First Half of the Year!
