The celebration aimed to strengthen the bond between the Academy and its graduates, bridging the past and the present, and highlighting the successful alumni who have contributed to the Academy's journey and elevated its name locally and internationally. The day also served as an opportunity to acknowledge the alumni's accomplishments and showcase the Academy's efforts in developing education and scientific research, underscoring its pivotal role in preparing competent cadres capable of meeting global changes and achieving sustainable development

AASTMT President's Speech: A Legacy of Excellence and a Future of Innovation



In his opening address, H.E. Prof. Dr. Ismail Abdel Ghafar welcomed the attendees, describing the occasion as one where hearts reconnect, and memories of academic struggle and achievement resurface. He affirmed that this day is not merely a celebration, but "a message of belonging and a renewal of the covenant between the Academy and its children across generations." He also called for prayers for the founder of the Academy, the late Dr. Gamal El Din Mokhtar.

The AASTMT President spoke with pride about the Academy's foundation over fifty years ago with an ambitious vision, stating, "As we celebrate these decades of giving, we can proudly say that we have succeeded in building a leading educational institution that everyone is proud to belong to."

Global Recognition: Dr. Abdel Ghafar emphasized the Academy's leading regional and international position in maritime education and training, noting repeated visits by high-level international officials, including Secretaries-General of the International Maritime Organization (IMO). He proudly recalled a quote from a former IMO Secretary-General to H.E. President Abdel Fattah El-Sisi in 2015: "You have a treasure in Alexandria in maritime transport, which is the Arab Academy."

Latest Achievements: He highlighted the Academy's recent achievement of ranking first among Egyptian universities in the latest Times classification, attributing this success to the support of the host country, the Arab League, and the dedication of the faculty and staff.

Alumni Impact: The Academy now boasts over 100,000 graduates, many of whom hold influential leadership positions in governments, private sectors, and global companies, including prominent figures in politics, sports, and technology at companies like Microsoft, Google, Tesla, and Amazon.

Forward-Looking Expansion

Dr. Abdel Ghafar stressed that AASTMT is constantly focused on the future. Recent expansions include:

- The opening of the New Alamein Branch, a model for smart universities.
- The launch of the Colleges of Human Medicine, Dentistry, and Pharmacy.
- The Academy's pioneering role in graduating the first student from the Artificial Intelligence program in Egypt.
- The announcement of establishing a new College of Physical Therapy this year.

He also highlighted the Academy's crucial role in community service and youth support through its Entrepreneurship Center and the Regional Informatics Center, which hosts major international competitions, contributing to building a globally competitive digital generation.

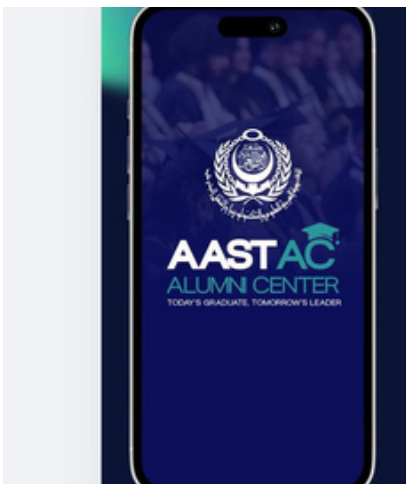


Alumni Association Updates and New Services



Dr. Ahmed Ghazal, Executive Director of the Alumni Center

welcomed the attendees, reiterating that the Association serves as a permanent bridge of communication. He announced several key new services and initiatives:



- **Specialized Career Platform:** The launch of a new employment platform in cooperation with Icareer, offering graduates real opportunities with major companies both inside and outside Egypt, along with career guidance and interview skills training.
- **Medical Card Service:** A new service providing exclusive discounts across a wide network of medical service providers (hospitals, labs, pharmacies) throughout Egypt for alumni and their families.
- **Alumni Chapters Initiative:** Enhancing the Alumni Chapters concept globally, with a successful example in Kuwait led by Eng. Loay Adnan. The initiative is set to expand to countries like Libya, Sudan, and Saudi Arabia to build a more influential global alumni network.

Dr. Ghazal also emphasized the importance of fundraising to support the Association's projects, acknowledging the generous contribution of Dr. Sherin Abbas Helmy in equipping the dental labs at the Alamein Branch.

Following the speeches, H.E. Prof. Dr. Ismail Abdel Ghafar honored several alumni from various generations. The ceremony concluded with Captain Walid Gouda, Chairman of Petromarine, presenting a commemorative shield to the AASTMT President, followed by a group of Palestinian alumni presenting a memorial painting of the city of Jerusalem.

AASTMT and Canadian Education Council Launch Strategic Partnership for International Graduate Employment



In a significant move to enhance global employment opportunities for Arab youth, the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport (AASTMT) has announced a strategic partnership with the Canadian Education Council (CEC). This partnership is designed to equip AASTMT graduates with an "International Employment License," opening up broad avenues for work in the global market through the CEC's electronic employment platform.

Key Highlights of the Agreement

- **Exclusive Status:** This agreement marks a qualitative step, as AASTMT will become the sole accredited International Employment Center for the Canadian Education Council in the Arab Republic of Egypt.
- **Delegation Visit:** To officially launch the partnership, a delegation of CEC representatives is visiting Egypt for several days, starting Saturday, August 24, 2025.
- **Informational Seminars:** Awareness seminars will be organized to detail the process for obtaining the International Employment License and maximizing the available international job opportunities for AASTMT graduates:

Tuesday, August 26: Informational seminar and training for staff at the "Accredited International Testing Center" on using the CEC's international employment platform at the Abu Qir Branch in Alexandria. Wednesday, August 27: A similar informational seminar will be held at the Heliopolis Branch in Cairo. The objective of these seminars is to highlight the mechanism for obtaining the International Employment License and how AASTMT graduates can benefit from the international job opportunities available.

AASTMT Abu Qir Hosts Seminar and Training for Canadian International Employment Platform

The Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport (AASTMT) and the Canadian Council on Education (CEC) officially launched their strategic partnership with back-to-back seminars at AASTMT's campuses:

- **Abu Qir Headquarters: August 26, 2025**
- **Heliopolis Campus: August 27, 2025**

The core focus of these launch events was the introduction of the "International Employ ability License." Under the new agreement, AASTMT will serve as the sole CEC-accredited career center in Egypt authorized to issue this license to its graduates via the Council's online platform.

The entire AASTMT community is proud of Mostafa Asal's success, which reflects his dedication and talent while bringing honor to both the Academy and Egypt.

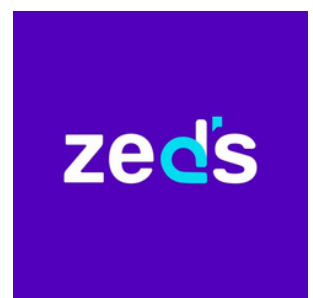

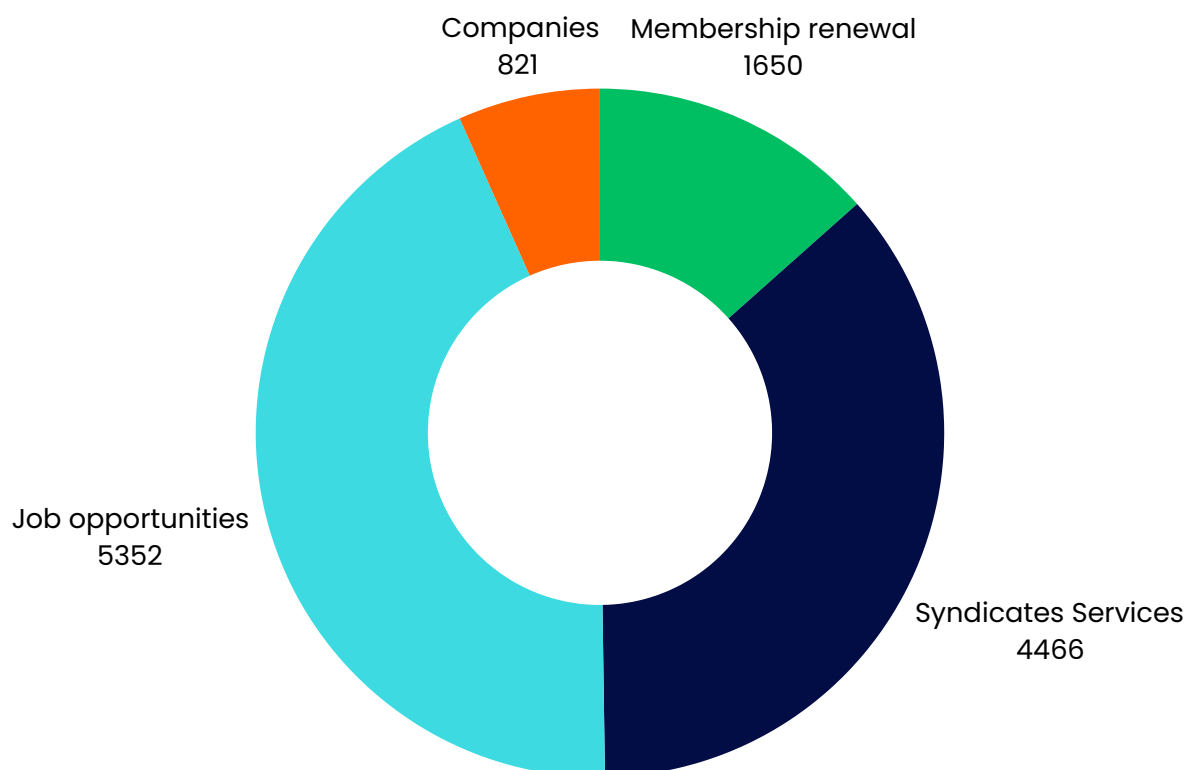
