About UPGRADE:

Urban and transPortation reGeneration for Reducing Automobile Dependency in mEna area

UPGRADE is a multi-country project for Egypt and Lebanon. It addresses the challenge of urban mobility and its availability, by directing the development of higher education, research and business to serve the needs of unprivileged minorities in the South-Mediterranean region.

Outcomes of the UPGRADE project:

Under WP2 each Benefeciary Universities have revised the four modules outlines by an external expert reviewer, who provided a feedback about the relevance and significance of the courses, and made further suggestions for improvement. Then, the Beneficiary Universities made the necessary changes to the course outlines with the agreement of Partner Universities. Subsequently, the courses detailed content (lectures, teaching materials, assignments, evaluation methods, etc.) was developed by Partners in coordination with Beneficiaries. New modules were accredited and inaugurated within each Beneficiary University.

In light of capacity building for teaching staff, four Training of Trainers (ToT) took place between July to Septemeber, where Beneficiaries have visited each Partner University to gain an insight on designing and elaborating course content to address the subject of "Sustainable Urban Mobility". Training participants also discussed the various qualitative and quantitative methods throughout the delivered courses.

These modules will be taught for undergraduate and postgraduate programs in the Beneficiary Universities between September 2022 and September 2023. Each module is assigned to a Partner University for supervision and regular feedback.

Under WP3 the Egyptian and Lebanese partners have purshased and installed the designated equipment (hardware, software) and inaugurated the SUMP lab.

WP4 have recently embarked with the delivery of new courses in the four Beneficiary Universities in Egypt and Lebanon.

UPGRADE project has successfully conducted 4 Training of Trainers where staff from Beneficiary Universities have visited the EU Universities, aiming to increase local capability and to design course content and provide lectures on "Sustainable Urban Mobility Planning". Training at different EU Universities allow European Professors to share their experiences, competences and best practices within their participation as trainers.
