


15.3.2 Monitoring IUCN and other Conservation Species Policies

AASTMT Monitoring IUCN & Conservation Species Policy Presenting Evidence of Events and Involvement Update-2025

The AASTMT "Monitoring IUCN and Conservation Species Policy" emphasizes year-round monitoring and protection of species listed on the IUCN Red List within the Academy's campuses. It strongly promotes ethical, non-lethal research methods, such as collecting DNA, seeds, or feathers, to minimize harm to wildlife. The policy integrates biodiversity education into academic curricula, student projects, and staff training, strengthening both awareness and capacity. It also aligns with regional and global environmental frameworks — AASTMT participates in international projects like TouMaLi and global forums such as IMO MEPC 82. Finally, the report outlines clear performance indicators (e.g., training numbers, participation in international events) and has a structured action plan to ensure consistent progress.
