

These facilities are dedicated to offering superior healthcare and medical services to students, faculty, and staff. Each clinic is staffed with top-tier specialists, consultants, and nursing professionals, covering a full spectrum of medical disciplines, and equipped with state-of-the-art diagnostic and therapeutic technology



Significant enhancements have been made in specific areas, such as the dental clinic. This facility now boasts a new, cutting-edge dental unit, complete with integrated radiation capabilities. Furthermore, advancements in ocular specialization equipment have been introduced to elevate the quality of patient care



To optimize efficiency and ensure the provision of high - quality, effective treatment, AASTMT medical clinics at all locations utilize a barcode system for pharmaceutical management. This system streamlines the dispensing of essential medications, saving time and effort for students and staff.

Additionally, the clinics are supported by a modern ambulance service, specifically acquired for the swift and safe transport of emergency cases
