DESCRIPTION

Sustainable Development is crucial for global well-being. AASTMT aligns with the UN 2030 Agenda, actively combating climate change and advocating for the preservation of marine life. Through education and awareness initiatives, we address climate change impacts on health, biodiversity, water resources, and agriculture. Our commitment extends to Large Marine Ecosystems, focusing on reducing pollution, sustainable management, and combating ocean acidification.

AASTMT involves students and the community in safeguarding land-based ecosystems, emphasizing their role in human health, food systems, and climate change mitigation. We stress the significance of terrestrial ecosystems in providing essential goods, regulating water quality, and mitigating natural disaster risks like floods and landslides.

- Integrate ecosystems and biodiversity values into national and local planning, development • processes, poverty reduction strategies, and accounts.
- Conserve the world's forests, mountains, drylands, and wetlands to promote sustainable development and halt deforestation to protect natural habitats and threatened species.

POLICY STATEMENT

AASTMT is committed to achieving the UN 2030 Agenda and taking urgent actions to combat climate change and its impacts and preserve the life below water. AASTMT provides educational programs and initiatives to enhance society's knowledge about climate change and its consequent effects on human health, biodiversity, water resources, and agriculture. We raise a flag warning among our community that climate change symptoms are increasing rapidly, accelerating the intensity of extreme weather events such as heatwaves, droughts, floods, and tropical cyclones. This is causing aggravating water management problems, reducing agricultural production and food security, increasing health risks, damaging critical infrastructure, and interrupting the provision of essential services such as water and sanitation, education, energy, and transport.

AASTMT is also committed to enhancing society's knowledge about the Large Marine Ecosystems (LMEs) pressures and their adverse effect on the biodiversity, food chain, and ocean acidification phenomenon. We raise awareness on ways to prevent and reduce marine pollution; further the sustainable management and protection of marine and coastal ecosystems; address the impacts of ocean acidification; regulate harvesting, and end overfishing, illegal, unreported, and unregulated fishing, and destructive fishing practices.

AASTMT is ambitious to involve our students and the community in protecting, restoring, and promoting all land-based ecosystems and biodiversity. We teach our students that sustainable ecosystems are essential for human health through safe water supplies, sustainable food systems, crops, pollinators, soil, medicines, and climate change mitigation. We hold events to emphasize the importance of terrestrial ecosystems to provide a series of goods, raw materials for construction and energy, food, the capture of carbon, maintenance of soil quality, provision of habitat for biodiversity, maintenance of water quality, as well as regulation of water flow and erosion control. Thus, highlighting its importance in reducing the risks of natural disasters such as floods and landslides, regulating climate and maintaining the productivity of agricultural systems.
