The Arab Academy signed a joint cooperation agreement for training engineers and technicians of Arab industries for manufacturing and obtaining technological courses. Advanced in UK within EU programmes.

This came during the Industry Advisory Council, which was held at the branch of the Arab Academy of Science, Technology and Maritime Transport in the New Alamein City.

The agreement was signed by the Arab side for Manufacturing Major General Dr. "Mujahid Al-Farmawi", Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Helwan Factory on behalf of the Arab Industrial Authority, and on behalf of the Academy, His Excellency Dr.Ismail Abdel Ghafar Ismail Farag, President of The Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport, and on behalf of Yuklan University, United Kingdom, Dr. "A Hamad Helmy Ansi, Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Engineering for Development and Projects.

According to the sides of the agreement, the University of Yuklan bears all the costs of the training courses, and the EU bears travel costs, in support of the University of Yoklan in cooperation with the Arab Academy of Science, Technology and Maritime Transport to develop the Egyptian industry and achieve the vision of the State of Egypt This is in sustainable development *context* in the light of the rapid evolution of digital transformation.

The Council also included the launch of the joint training program between the University of Yuklan, the Arab Academy, and the Arab Industry Authority, aiming to domesticate technology and acquire young people's skills in the labor market, the program aims to train young graduates at the geographical level of the Arab Republic of Egypt.

The cooperation also includes the invitation of the Arab Authority for Manufacturing factories to attend the Industry Council at the Faculty of Engineering of the University of Yuklan in its session held in April 2020, in the light of the localization of technology and the creation of a climate of international cooperation between Egyptian factories, companies and international entities.
