Reference framework

The initiative takes place within the project MAIA TAQA whose objective is to develop and promote new innovative services in three Mediterranean areas: Egypt, Jordan and Lebanon.

Subject of the Eol

Identification of service providers to organize the launch of the AASTMT IOSS on August 28th, 2022. The service provider has to have previous experience in event management, media management, logistics, and technical support. Required tasks and services are mentioned below.

Procedure

All the interested parties can submit an application in response to this EoI, using the format "Application form". On the basis of applications received and in compliance with the stated requirements the selection committee will evaluate all received applications and service providers' profiles (including previous works). The applications will be evaluated and accordingly subjects contracted based on the offer, previous works, and ability to fulfill requirements.

AASTMT has the right to select the service provider with the specific and adequate skills required according to the evaluation of the selection committee.

Required tasks and services for the IOSS event management include the following:

- All related communication and event management arrangements, protocols, VIP reception, registration etc.
- All conference materials design and printings (conference theme, PowerPoint presentation background, invitations, roll-ups, backdrops, banners, name tags, agenda, give away bags, pens and notebooks)
- Catering (around 100 physical attendees)
- English-Arabic and Arabic-English interpretation service for all conference sessions from 10 am to 3 pm (including all interpretation equipment)
- Professional video and photo shooting
- _ Media management and coverage of the event
- _ Logistical means for attendees to arrive at the campus
- _ Technical support during the zoom webinar sessions

Execution of the event

IOSS launch will take place on Sunday 28th of August at the Arab Academy for Science, Technology and Maritime Transport, Abou Kir campus, Alexandria from 10 am till 3 pm at El Farsy conference hall then the guests will be taken in a tour to IOSS location.

Financial conditions

The value of the service will be determined based on the submitted offers and the quality of the proposed services within the budget allocated to the launch event in the project.

Profile of service providers

Interested service providers must have previous experience in event management and are cable of providing the above-mentioned services. It is necessary to fill all fields in the application, in addition to sending a full profile with previous undertaken services and events.

The adopted selection criteria:

- _ English proficiency of organizers
- _ Available registration papers
