Contracting subject

Reference framework

The initiative takes place within the project TECHLOG whose objective is to strengthen research-industry links in the (trans)port sector by establishing a permanent cross-border EU-Med space where research organizations and (trans)port industries co-create, test, and share new Technology Transfer Initiatives based on advanced simulation technologies.

To this purpose AASTMT is assigning a full-time technical logistics and capacity building expert as a member of its TECHLOG project human resources team to contribute to work packages related to market research, capacity building, logistics technology transfer and pilot actions.

Subject of the Eoi

Identification of experts able to support, contribute to work packages related to market research, capacity building, logistics technology transfer and pilot actions. The expert must be available full time for this assignment physically in Egypt. Required qualifications are explained in detail below.

Procedure

All the interested experts can submit their CVs in response to this Eoi, highlighting their experience and skills according to the declared requirements. On the basis of applications received and in compliance with the stated requirements the selection committee will evaluate all sent CVs. The individual experts' CV will be evaluated and contracted based on the skills and experiences declared. AASTMT has the right to select the experts with the specific and adequate skills required according to the evaluation of the selection committee.



Execution of required tasks

Tasks will be conducted at AASTMT Alexandria branch or activities running at any location, in addition, to online meeting and documentation work. The job starts on the 15th of May 2022.

Financial conditions

The value of the service will be modulated on an hourly / daily basis according to the level of experience and competence of the individual expert.

Profile of trainers

Interested Experts must have skills and experience in logistics and capacity building areas, in addition to, previous international experiences. He/she should be available for a full time and has more than 10 years experience in the mentioned areas.
