

## studying plan and conditions at Hull program

1. program language: English, the student must pass the B2 CEPT English language examination (from the Academy's Cambridge Center) and obtain a minimum of C, in addition to the personal interview.
2. 4 academic years / 8 semesters.
3. The first year, Foundation year, is a basic year for all majors.
4. The major specialization starts from the third semester (second year) Major (Transportation logistics - international trade logistics - supply chain logistics, only as there is no specialization in energy logistics).
5. The minor starts from the fifth semester (the third year), which means that you can graduate from the college with 2 majors, not one, and which are not found in many universities.
6. The student gets two certificates, one from the Academy and the other from Hull University, despite his presence in the Arab Republic of Egypt and the provision of travel expenses.
7. Students can study any semester after the first year at Hull University
8. Assessment and examination systems accredited by Hull University
9. Program fees = academic expenses in addition to \$ 800 for each academic semester



## Admission requirements

Admission depends on the applicant's performance at the secondary level, so that the applicant must have a recognized high school diploma with a minimum score that complies with the requirements of the Supreme Council of Higher Education as follows:

1. Egyptian and Arab certificates, the minimum admission percentage is approved according to the council's regulations.
2. The top of the Egyptian universities with different divisions (mathematics - science or literature).
3. IGCSE: Completion of 8 OL courses with a minimum grade of C.
4. American Diploma: SAT according to the instructions of the Supreme Council of Egyptian Universities.
5. Filling online application form of Hull University.
